The Lord's Prayer was said in closing. Respectfully submitted by Keri Skroch, Secretary

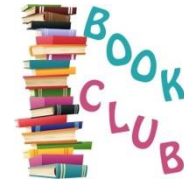

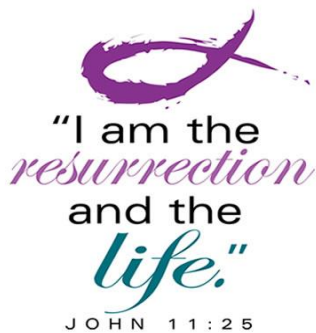
