PIONEER LUTHERAN COUNCIL MEETING June 3, 2021

Present were President Valerie Hicks, Pastor Pam Wells via phone, Charlotte Mickelson, Milan Kruse, Kevin and Laura Quail, Julie Peterson. Val called the meeting to order. Laura led the devotions.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Val read the minutes from May via phone as Keri was absent. A correction was noted - corrections need to be spelled out and listed. Milan moved; Kevin seconded to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Julie provided copies of the report. Kevin moved, Milan seconded, and the motion passed.

2. safe/records: Kevin will call Keri to see if safe has been ordered. Milan volunteered with the effort of buying the safe which will house church records.

copies with notes/corrections. Council members discussed some of the questionable items. Julie had found the date of the recent document: March 11, 2012. Pastor Pam and Julie will search for the mission statement. After some reading/study of the document, council members will address it again.

2. The condition of the steeple was noted. Kevin called Ben Fitzgerald to help with the cleaning - it will require a boom truck. Also asking Ben for a quote to trim lower branches on the big cottonwood in the ditch.
3. Cleaning List is available for church members to sign up for a specific task to do when it fits their schedule, then sign off on the list.
4. A discussion about outreach to existing members and to invite new members to return to/join Pioneer Lutheran. Council recommends

forming a committee to address that issue.

5. Fall Festival date set for September 12, 2021.
6. Julie announced the Rural Water System is holding a drive through Open House on June 8th.
7. Pastor's Report: Pastor presented 2 bills: Mother's Day donuts and flowers for Terrell's memorial. Pastoral contacts of 11 in May. Hy Vee credit card has been returned and is now with Julie. Julie volunteered to be the shopper for any kitchen/cleaning items. Denise Nepodal also returned a records folder for the Youth Group. Valerie agreed to add her name to the Youth Group savings account at the bank which requires two signatures. June 6th Sunday communion option at the rail will be offered. Pastor can now do in person pastoral visits.

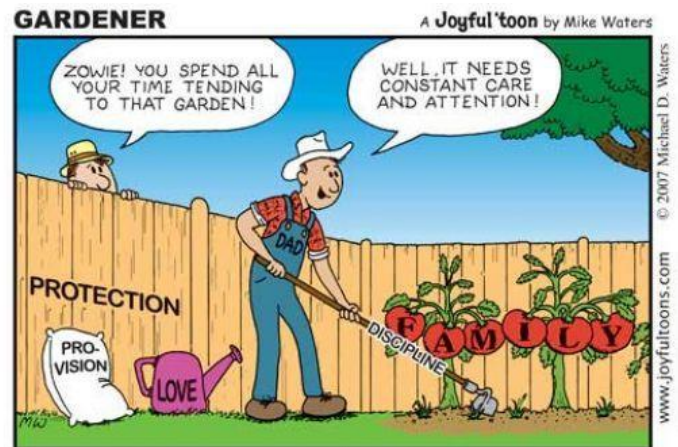

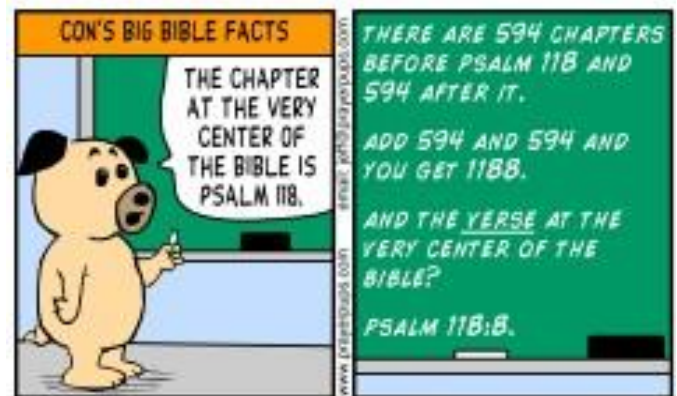


Faithful, to God and family.

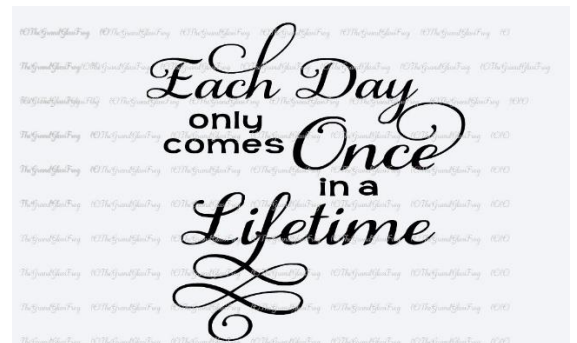
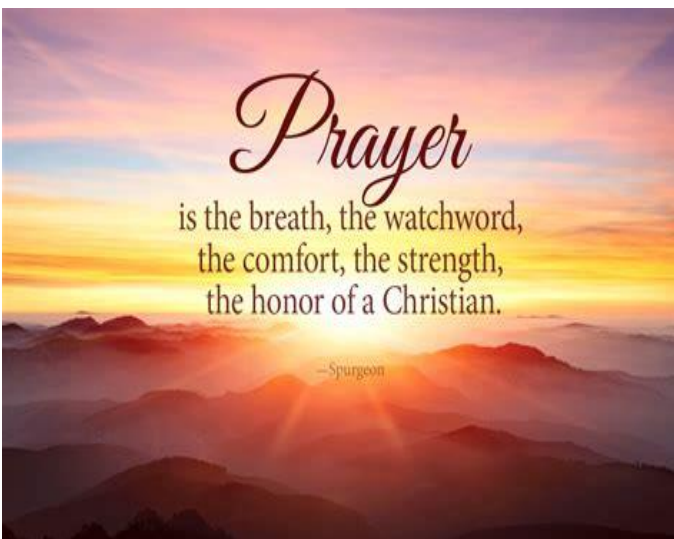
