PIONEER LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING November 2,2021

On November 2, 2021, five Church Council members met at the Church. Pastor Pam, Keri Skroch, Milan Kruse were absent.

Laura Quail offered devotions before the meeting started.

Secretary's Report read by Laura had one correction, then Kevin Quail moved and Charlotte Mickelson seconded that the report was approved as read. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report was offered by Julie Petersen who attended the meeting virtually. Laura moved and Kevin seconded the motion to approve the report. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

Concerning the membership list: the newsletter will ask members to update information if needed.

Concerning the church records: the fireproof safe has been delivered, placed in the side room of the altar and historical records have been placed inside by Arlene Madsen and Charlotte Concerning the constitution: in preparing for the January Annual Meeting, a small committee of Julie, Charlotte and Val Hicks will meet at 1:00 PM on Nov 10th to review the corrections and additions to the document.

Noted the clean up of the Cry Room and the Youth Room which Julie, Val and Laura accomplished.

Concerning the ideas of the PR group: Charlotte and Laura listed several ideas of outreach to community. November's plan – provide a meal to share during this month of Thanksgiving. Julie moved to budget \$150.00 for the event, Kevin seconded and the motion passed. Council also discussed the idea of caroling in White in December and to offer bags of candy/treats to some residents. Also proposed opening doors to community during Lenten Soup Suppers. Other ideas were discussed but planning will wait till closer to a specific month. Val is in the process of creating a new blank notecard featuring a photo of the church and simplifying/updating the current brochure.

Concerning the hot water issue in the kitchen: Charlotte reported that she had visited with Ekern about their findings/suggestions. Charlotte suggested the council get a 2nd opinion on the issue. Laura moved that Christianson Plumbing in Hendricks, MN, be contacted, Julie seconded and the motion passed. Kevin volunteered to call the company.

Val updated the Council on the progress of the Call Committee. That Committee is updating information that will be sent to LCMC in the pastoral search.

Concerning preparation for the Annual Meeting in Jan of 2022: Newsletter will ask members to indicate interest in serving on Council or Committees. Note: MJ replaced Paul Nepodal on the Audit Committee.

Concerning confirmation: Pastor Pam has begun instruction with Preston Reed, a 7th grader.

There will be sign up sheets to help out with food needed for this meal. Please check the table with sign up sheets!!






