2. Pioneer Cemetery Association requested to receive 50 % of the Fall Festival proceeds. Kevin moved to approve the request, Julie seconded it. Motion passed.

4. Concerning a swing set for the church grounds: Julie volunteered to check on prices.

5. Next meeting: April 5, 2022, Tuesday, 6 PM

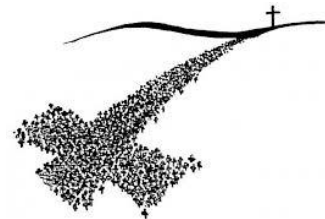


Save the Date!!

If you attended worship, there in December 2021 you do not need to fill out the form for a background check again.

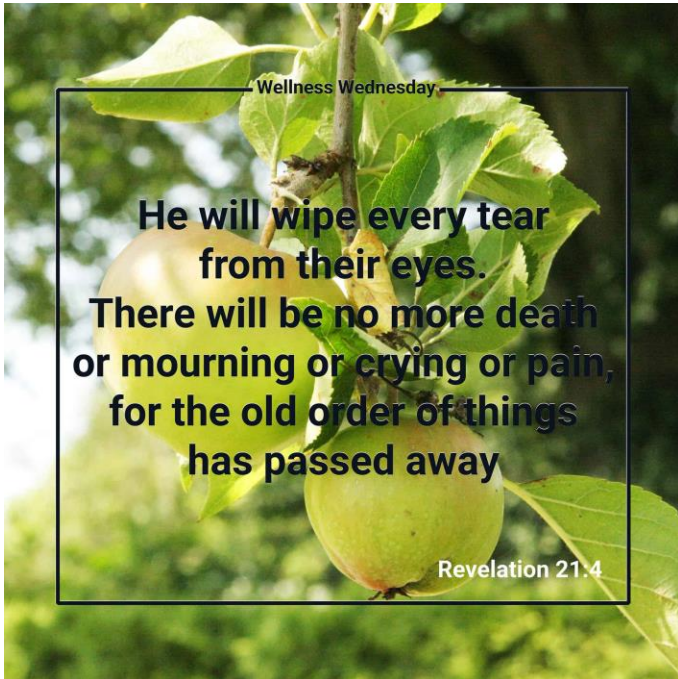
