### PIONEER LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING MAY 4, 2022

Five members of Pioneer Lutheran Church Council met May 4, 2022, at the Church. Absent was Laura Quail.

President Valerie Hicks opened the meeting at 6:05 PM.

The meeting started with devotions led by Bill Powers.

The secretary read the minutes of the April meeting which were approved as read with a motion by Bill and seconded by Julie Peterson. Motion passed.

The treasurer's report was also approved with a motion by Charlotte Mickelson and seconded by Bill. Motion passed. Julie reported that a \$2.00 increase to the insurance the Church carries would cover Pioneer Cemetery also.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- 2. Val continues to work on digitizing past records.

- 3. The Outreach Ministry is planning the May Friendship Luncheon that will take place on May 21, 2022. Help is needed in providing salads and working in the kitchen. A reminder of the Paint Sign Party hosted by In Other Words is scheduled for June 8, 2022 at 6:00 PM in the fellowship hall.
- 4. Facilities committee will remove the dead tree east of the church on May 12 during the cemetery clean up effort. Scaffolding is needed to replace the light bulb in the sanctuary.
- 5. A short discussion was had on adding a play set outside. No action taken.
- 6. New kitchen faucets were gifted by Carole and Jim Hansen and installed by Steve Hicks. Many thanks to them.
- 7. A discussion on the kitchen counter/sink was had. Bill moved, Charlotte seconded to explore dropping in a large sink to cover the damaged portion of counter. A max budget of \$700. was approved. Kevin Quail is doing the research.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

1. Concerning Mother's Day celebration: Rather than donuts or flowers, it was suggested that 2 fruit pizzas be purchased by Julie. Charlotte moved, Bill seconded in agreement. Motion passed.

- 2. The room used as an office was evaluated and all agreed some painting needed to occur. Charlotte agreed to talk to Dana Crooks about doing that work.
- 3. A clean up day for the Cemetery is scheduled for May 12 at 6:30 PM. Bring rakes and gloves.
- 4. Val volunteered to drive her ponies in the Pioneer Days parade on July 16th in White. Bill volunteered to help with some decoration related to Pioneer Lutheran Church.
- 5. Council discussed distribution of communion on Christmas and Easter church services. Agreement that it should occur.
- 6. Pastoral Call Committee update: Julie moved; Bill seconded to move into Executive Session. Motion passed. Council moved out of Executive Session with a motion by Charlotte and seconded by Kevin. Motion passed.
- 7. Next meeting is June 1, 2022, at 6 PM.
