Dear Friends in Christ,

My heart is still full of deep joy after our "all church" worship service and potluck last month. I am reminded of Paul's words: "For as in one body we have many members, and all the members do not have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another. Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them."

I am excited about the ministry opportunities that await us, one of which will be an all church Bible study beginning Saturday, September 21 at 10:00 am at Pioneer. The title of the study is "Untangling Faith: Reclaiming Hope in the Questions Jesus Asked" by Amberly Neese. This study will take us on a journey of untangling some common faith questions that sometimes tie us up in knots of confusion, discouragement, and disillusionment. Regardless of where we are on our faith journey, we all have questions, and the good news is that our questions can actually help us untangle our faith. Jesus loves questions! In the Gospels, he asks over three hundred questions and directly answers only three. By asking so many questions, Jesus invites us to ask, seek, and grapple with our own questions. He knows that our questions can be holy guides leading us to truth and deeper connection with God.

Dates the study will meet: September 21, 28; October 5, 19, 26 & November 2. We will meet at Pioneer at 10:00 am. The chapters are not tied together, so come when can and bring a friend!

Confirmation begins Sunday, September 8 at noon at the White United Methodist Church and I am excited to have 6 students!
Confirmation dates are September 8, 22;
October 20, 27; November 10 and 24. We will begin with a meal followed by our lesson. If anyone would like to furnish the noon meal please let me know!

Advent preparations are also underway for an all church adult study!
