Greetings in the name of our risen Savior Jesus Christ,

This month we will celebrate Pentecost as we remember the day the Holy Spirit descended upon the followers of Jesus reminding them that everyone can now know God's presence everywhere and at all times. Pentecost comes after Easter on the church calendar because historically Pentecost followed the experience of the risen Christ. Pentecost transformed the defeated followers of Jesus into courageous, fearless and bold witnesses through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The disciples had been waiting in obedience and prayer, likely uncertain of what to expect. Then suddenly heaven invades the room. The people who once hid in fear now speak boldly. Ordinary people become empowered to carry an extraordinary message. A frightened gathering of disciples became a thriving, learning, growing and sharing community.

The Spirit didn't come just to give a warm feeling or a personal experience---the Spirit came to empower the Church for mission. Pentecost is not just about being filled; it also about being sent. The Gospel goes out in every language, crossing boundaries and inviting all people to know Jesus.

Pentecost asks where we've seen signs of God moving among us. Are we waiting on

something from God? Remember, Pentecost came after obedience and prayer. We must remain faithful in our waiting. The early disciples were told to wait upon God until the power came. They waited and the power did come.

Pentecost asks if we are filled with the Spirit's power? If not, pray and ask God for a fresh filling. The Spirit gives gifts and boldness to all who ask.

Pentecost asks if we're using our spiritual gifts to reach others for Christ. Pentecost reminds us that every believer is called to be a witness. May our Pentecost prayer be:

Holy Spirit, thank You for coming in power on Pentecost. Fill me anew this season. Ignite in me a boldness to speak truth, a love for others, and a passion for your mission. Let your presence flow through me, just as it did through the early Church. Use me to bring light into the world. In Jesus' name, Amen.


